Continental Diesel FADEC Service Link

- Continental Diesel Engines are controlled by the electronic FADEC system which logs engine data for service and diagnostic reasons. This data is vital to service centers in order to find the cause of possible errors and has to be submitted.
- The FADEC Service Link uses the diagnostic port installed with every Continental Diesel Engine to download FADEC data. For some installations an independent power supply might be necessary. This can be provided by a separate adapter in connection with a standard DC socket that has to be present in the aircraft. Please refer to the attached list or consult your local service center whether it is required in your application.
- The included USB drive acts as a storage device during download and enables the user to transport the data to any location from where it can be sent.

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User Interaction

- Button »DOWNLOAD« Press to download engine data and event logs of the last 10 hours (Download time: 4 min).
- Button »EXTENDED DOWNLOAD«
 Press to download all available data.
 - external ground power supply is mandatory!
 - Download time: up to 45 min)

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System Feedback - Meaning of LEDs

- LED rows 1 and 2 show process status.
- »USB Error« USB flash drive is not connected to the FADEC SERVICE LINK.
- »CAN Error« Suboptimal CAN-Bus connection. In case LED does not switch off after a few seconds re-connect the FADEC SERVICE LINK to interface.
- »Service Error« reserved for further use.
- Buttons Illuminated buttons indicate valid options
